Celebrated portrait photographer Monni Must started making portraits of Holocaust survivors after the untimely death of her daughter Miya.

“I was terrified that Miya would be forgotten – not just from the world, but as the years went on, that her memory would start to subside in my mind,” says Monni. “I need to speak to people who had experienced such depth of pain but then rediscovered hope.”

Her first book, *Living Witnesses*, featured 92 Detroit survivors – crisp, startling, portraits of beautiful people whose stories inspire and compel. That project was driven by Monni’s personal heartache and a determination to find purpose and meaning in the wake of unspeakable pain.

It is survivors who have it hardest – making meaning out of senseless tragedy. Here Monni Must conveys the courage and determination of a strength that resides in each of us, though it may be buried deep within.
